ings, the magnificent churches, the prestigious Palace district, the world-famous Herzog August Library and the Lessinghaus – together they make up a work of art which is unmatched in Niedersachsen! By the way, did you know that Wolfenbüttel is particularly famous for its herbal liqueur, Jägermeister? Originating from

the town of Wolfenbüttel, it has meanwhile conquered 74 countries. So make sure you sample it when you are in town!
